Bob Burroughs's compositions have been widely published by a variety of companies including AGHER, AMSI, Choristers Guild, Exaltation Publications, Heritage Music Press, Laurel Press, Lorenz Publishing Company, Monarch Music, The Sacred Music Press, and Triune Music. In addition, Mr. Burroughs authored *This Idea Will Work*.

Mr. Burroughs hails from Tazewell, Virginia. He and his wife, Esther, were married in 1958, and they are the parents of two children, David Lloyd and Melody. They are also the proud grandparents of four granddaughters and one grandson.

Burroughs has served churches both full time and part time, as well as teaching on three Universities as Composer-In-Residence. He served as the Director of the Florida Baptist Convention Church Music Department till his retirement in 2002.
