### Andrew Bruhn

Andrew Bruhn is a versatile musician, actively working as a choral conductor, composer, and trumpeter. Andrew is currently Director of Choral Music at Rockford Christian Schools in IL, where he teaches 6-12th grade choirs, AP Music Theory, basic music theory, and vocal directs for the musical. He is also the Westminster Presbyterian Church in Rockford, IL. Mr. Bruhn sper director of the Luther Seminary Choir and Luther Brass in St. Paul MN. Ae received his Master of Sacred Music degree in choral conducting from Luther S finary and St. Olaf College, where he studied conducting with Anton Arm her Aspaas, and Mark Stover. The American Choral Directors Association and Na for Music Education have published Andrew's writing on cal musi education. He was nominated for a Golden Apple Teaching Awa so was 97.5FM of Rockford's Teacher of the Week in 2019. His s nool choir regularly receive superior ratings in organizational contests, and have been a f tured per rmer at the Illinois Music Education Conference (All-State).

Mr. Bruhn studied composition with Evid Cherwien and Alice Parker. His music is published by Choristers Guild, GIA, MexicSpoke, Alfred Music, Carl Fischer, and Concordia. His music is performed by elementary through university level community bands and choirs. He was honored to tave two of his pieces selected for a J.W. Pepper Editors' Choice. Andrew wan the 20 7 IL American Choral Directors Association Composition Contest, and the same a seni-finalist for The American Prize in Choral Composition in 2019.

As a trumpeter he has performed with many fine ensembles, including the Civic Orchestra of Chicago, training on testra for the Chicago Symphony; Chicago Youth Symphony Orchestra; and Interlochen's World Youth Symphony Orchestra. Andrew studied at the Interlochen 1 rts Camp, the Aspen Music Festival and School, and earned a BM in Trum et Performance from Wheaton College. He was the October 2004 winner of the annatural Tampet Guild's Young Artist Award. His solo playing has been broadcast on Tallutheran Hour and on WFMT 98.7FM Chicago's Classical Fine Arts Station. Mr. Billin lives in Belvidere, IL with his musical wife, Lydia, their two daughters, and rolder retriever.
