
Robert W. Lehman, conductor, organist, harpsic ordist and composer, holds degrees in organ performance, conducting, church music, and an eart of doctorate in liturgical musicology where his particular focus is the ecclesia ical matter of the English Middle Ages beginning with chant and culmin ring in the complex polyphony of the late fifteenth-century Eton Choirbook.






