Upon arriving in the U.S. in 1990 he joined the Cathedral Choir of St Marks in Minneapolis under the direction of Howard Don Small and later, Jonathan Dimmock and Raymond Johnston and there began composing music. Without a formal music education beyond high school "Level", he has happily rested on the editorial advice and guidance of the talented d'arc. musicians that he has sung with. 
