David Hurd

David Hurd is recognized internationally as a concert organist, composer, choral conductor, and church musician. His principal studies have been at the Juilliard School, Oberlin College, and the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill. For nearly four decades he served on the faculty of The General Theological Seminary in New York City as Organist, Director of Chapel Music, and Professor of Church Music. In addition, he has taught at Duke University, Westminster Choir College, and Yale University. He was awarded first prizes in organ playing and improvisation at the 1977 International Congress of Organists and he concertizes under the representation of Phillip Truckenbrod Concert Artists. He is the composer of dozens of hymns, choral works, organ works, and hymns and his liturgical settings appear in hymnals of several religious denominations. In 2010 he became the fifteenth recipient of The American Guild of Organists' Distinguished Composer Award. He has performed at and composed for national and international events including conventions of the American Guild of Organists, the Association of Anglican Musicians, and the International Orgelfestival Haarlem. In 2016 Dr. Hurd was named Organist and Music Director at the Church of St. Mary the Virgin in New York City.

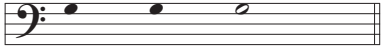

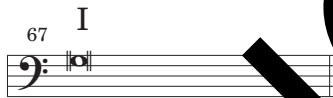
