Born in 1975, Alastair grew up in the Shetland Isles off the north East Coast of Scotland, UK. He studied at the Royal College of Music (London) with Joseph Horovitz and Dr. John Birch (1993 - 1997) winning prizes in composition, organ and music history, the Guildhall School of Music and Drama with Robert Saxton and Graham Elliot (1997 - 98) and Royal Holloway, University of London with Simon Holt (1998 - 2001) where he graduated with a PhD in composition. Whilst in London he was assistant organist at Wesley's Chapel, the Mother Church of World Methodism, and gave recitals at Scathedral, Westminster Abbey, Ely Cathedral, the Temple and St Brides Chach, Flort Street as well as throughout the UK.

Since moving to America in 2002 to take up the position of Music Director, the Coraopolis United Methodist Church near Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania Church near Pittsburgh near New York and Iow as well as presented workshops on new repertoire and composition. In 2007 he was it vited to perform at the Morelia International Organ Festival in Mexico where his programme of 20th century music was hailed as a highlight of the 41st festival. In 2010 he was appointed Director of the Pittsburgh Compline Choir who sing the Office of Compline on Sunday evenings in Pittsburgh Camous Heil Chapel. In 2017 he was appointed Minister of Music at Grace Congregation Church in Rutland, Vermont.

He has performed in collaboration of the various artists including choreographers, painters, sculptors and photographers be is also active as a producer, being recently involved in recording two CDs from St 1. I's Church in Akron, Ohio, and one from Waltham Abbey in Essex, UK.

As a composer he has the for almost very genre including an 80 minute chamber opera with a lifetto by Jo than Lennie based on the final flight of the Russian Astronaut, Vladir r Komarov. Assembles and soloists such as the Philharmonia Orchestra, Brunel, Continum and Corposer's Ensembles, Ixion, Gilde and Belmonte Quartets, Contempolary Court, No. Noise, Scottish Chamber Ensemble, Chroma, pianist Rolf Hind and mayo soprano Sarah Walker have performed his work.

His work and feature lat the Spitalfield's Festival, the Huddersfield Contemporary Music Festival, Vorfolk and Forwich Festival, Gregynog Festival, Hoxton Music Days, all the London Caundrals, and on London's South Bank at the Purcell Room. His music has also been broadca, on BBC Radios 3 and 4, and Radio Shetland.

Rece, by he has completed commissions for the New London Children's Choir, the Rothko Star g Trio, the University of Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra and violinist Roger Zahab who erformed his solo violin work A Reel Sweet Kiss in New York City and which was then by addast on BBC Radio Scotland. His latest works, Suite for Trumpet and Organ, A Checkes for the Young New Yorker's Chorus and Fanfares for the Pittsburgh Youth Philharmonic Orchestra were all premiered to much acclaim. In 2005 he won the William Mathias Composition Award and was a featured composer in the Kings Lynn Festival (UK). The groups Chroma, The Composer's Ensemble, Waltham Abbey Choir and the Pittsburgh Compline Choir have released his music on CD and iTunes.


