Christopher Maxim was born in Wrexham, North Wales in 1971. As a mall child he drove his grandfather to distraction with his impovisations in his grandmother's piano. He joined the choir of St Magare's Charle in 168 and, since then, his passion for choral and organ must has been central to his life. He began writing notated compositions in 1980.

Chris went on to be Organ Scholar and prize winn at the inversity of Bristol, and afterwards held a Research Study aship at Cardiff University, completing his PhD in music in 1996. Following a tral years lecturing at Cardiff and the Royal Welsh College of Music and Dama, he woved to London and into the secondary education sector.

An active conductor and organic Chris has been Director of Music at St. Matthew's, Bethnal reen since 2 03 and conducts the Giltspur Singers, a chamber choir assed by the City of ondon.

Chris' music is perfected around the world and has been broadcast on the radio in the Christian It has been featured in music festivals, recorded on several CD and is in the catalogues of a number of eminent publishing houses. Many pieces to be heard in performances available online.
