He is Professor Emerity of Musical Lebaron Valley College where he taught and chaired the Music Doartment. He as served as Adjunct Professor at Penn State Harrisburg where he aught in the School of Humanities.

Dr. Lau has had a varied career as a church musicial. He was a cently named Music Associate at the Cathedral of St. Stepher (Episcopal) in anisburg, PA, where he will co-lead diocesan Choral Evenson as well as participating in occasional Sunday morning Eucharists and special event. He is more than 350 choral and keyboard works published by the leading music publishing companies of the United States. He has been commissioned to write works for acciety of instrutions, churches and individuals and is a consistent winner of Special Awards and ASCAP for his work in published choral and keyboard works.

Dr. Lau is the former usic rector of le Harrisburg Choral Society and former Artistic Ense of Gettysburg, PA. He regularly presents organ and Director of Jubilate Cho on a vari of topics for churches as well as chapters of the American choral works Guild of Orga nemberships in ASCAP, the American Choral Directors American Guild of Organists. He was recently awarded an Alumni Association and t Citation by his alma ater, Lebanon Valley College, recognizing his contribution to the the college and his profession.
