## **Jay Wilcox**

Jay Wilcox (b.1954) has been the organist-choirmaster at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church, Burke, Virginia, since January 1, 2000, where he directs both the Adult and Youth Choirs. He has been active as a church musician in Northern Virginia since 1980, serving several Episcopal parishes in different capacities. In addition to his choral conducting and organ duties, he has composed a number of works for both the choirs he has directed and the congregations he has served. His approach to conducting and composition has been shaped by the fact that he has been a singer since childhood. From 1991 through 1995 he was a member of the Choir of Men and Boys at Washington Cathedral; since 1996 he has been fortunate to be a member of the Washington Bach Consort. While pursuing his musical career, Jay has also practiced law in Northern Virginia since 1978, when he received his J.D. from the College of William and Mary in Virginia. He and his wife Carrie live in Centreville, Virginia.
